



I SPY SHAWANO FAMILY SEARCH

Grab your crew (or walk alone) and complete this search as you stroll along the downtown area. Search sheets available for pickup at the Library or from our Library website.

- 1. Start at the Shawano County Library (128 S. Sawyer St.). Who is the flagpole in the front dedicated to?**
- 2. Walk north to Huckleberry Harbor.  Note the windmill! According to the signage  at the boat launch, what is the minimum size for a walleye and what is the bag limit?**
- 3. Continue walking west to Main St. Follow the walking path behind the Sheriff's Department to Heritage Park. Continue along the path to Sunset Island. According to the Sunset Island sign, what tribes hunted and fished here in days gone by? Walk the perimeter of the island. Did you spot the loon today? **
- 4. Walking on to Heritage Park...find the Zachow train depot.  What was it called? Take a selfie by the Railway Express Agency bench and send it to our Facebook page!**
- 5. Retrace your steps along the path behind the Sheriff's station. Make sure to check out the fishing piers! Someone was fishing the day we made this adventure and a large flock of geese landed on the island! Continue on to the Shawano County Court House. What**

- 6. Cross the street to the Fire Station . What animal is standing by the red bench and who is the bench dedicated to?**
- 7. Continue walking south along Main St. to the Spirit of Shawano Park on the corner of Main St. and Green Bay St. What do the two sculptures represent in Shawano's history?**
- 8. Many buildings on the 100 and 200 blocks of Main St. have names and dates engraved near the top of the buildings. We found 9 names and/or dates. 1 is quite faded. How many can you find?**
- 9. What is the address of the building that used to be Citizen's Bank on Main St.? Look hard for the street number!**
- 10. What is special about some of the windows at Stubborn Brother's Brewery  ? How many of those did you find?**
- 11. Cross the street to the Post Office  . What three things are engraved along the top of the building? Why do you think these would be engraved on a post office?**
- 12. Walk west on Presbyterian St. to Franklin Park. Continue walking west to Franklin St. and turn to the north. What is the woman doing on the park bench memorial? Factoid...it**

is dedicated to Linda Grams who was a librarian at the Shawano Library.

13. Turn east on Division. Looking at the Franklin Park arch, what is the city of Shawano slogan?

14. Keep walking east to check out the mural painted on the building on the corner of Main St. and Division St. What is depicted in the letter “S” and who is the artist?

15. Last stop coming up! Still walking east take a look at



Old Glory Candy. Search the outside of the building to find what creature is hidden in plain sight! Think it would



be fun to look for more? Google “Great Sturgeon Search Shawano” to get new 2020 clues to find all of the ones hidden in the downtown area.
